ALEXIS PINTURAULT

The Pinturault family, from grandparents to grandchildren, has always been passionate about mountains, skiing, sport and nature. Alexis Pinturault, Claude Pinturault's cadet son, has inherited his family's passion and become one of the best skiers in the world :

- Overall World Cup winner in 2020-21
- Triple world champion and eight-time medallist
- Three-time Olympic medallist (two bronze in giant slalom and one silver in combined)
- Winner of five small globes and a big crystal globe on his 30th birthday (Giant Slalom and Alpine Combined)

He is only the 3rd French skier in history to win the overall World Cup ranking after JC Killy and Luc Alphand. At the age of 32, he has 77 World Cup podium finishes, including 35 victories, making him the most successful French skier in history. In 2023, he won one of the best medals of his career. At home in Courchevel, he was crowned world combined champion.



ALTAÏ, THE MOUNTAINS OF GOLD

The Altaï, a natural and cultural treasure nestled in the heart of Eurasia.

Welcome to the mysterious and majestic Altai massif, a natural wonder located at the convergence of Russia, Mongolia, China and Kazakhstan. The Altai Massif stretches for almost 2,000 kilometres, forming a landscape of rugged mountains, vast plateaux, crystal-clear lakes and rushing rivers. The snowcapped peaks of the Altai, including Mount Belukha at 4,506 metres, dominate the horizon and offer breathtaking views.

This region is home to exceptional biodiversity, with rare species such as the snow leopard, the grey wolf and the Siberian brown bear.

The intangible link between Alexis Pinturault and these legendary peaks is, without a doubt, gold. In the Mongolian language, Altai means «Mountains of Gold», an appellation that resonates in perfect harmony with Alexis's heart, always beating to the rhythm of the quest for Gold. The two are united by the quest for excellence, whether in the preservation of nature or in the pursuit of sporting perfection.

Chalets Altaï are cosily located in a small hamlet in Courchevel Le Praz. In total confidentiality, they offer a privileged location in a cocoon of nature and gentleness. The panoramic view of the surrounding mountains is a living canvas, a fresco that reveals its magical colours from sunrise to sunset.

The three chalets have been designed to be a meeting point for those looking to find themselves and recharge their batteries. They are a sanctuary of serenity, a place where sharing and the joy of simple pleasures are celebrated. Arriving on skis, immersing yourself in a cosy space, the magic of a book by the fire or contemplating the sun melting into the horizon while sipping a delicious hot chocolate - each moment becomes an unforgettable experience, engraved in the memory.

Their construction is the result of meticulous reflection on the sacred universe of mountains, family and sport. For two years, dedicated teams worked to build these chalets in total immersion in the heart of the surrounding peaks. Wood, stone and glass blend elegantly to sublimate the four seasons that punctuate this majestic land.

La Maison Pinturault's unwavering commitment to sustainability has guided the construction of these chalets, making them as environmentally friendly as possible. Energy consumption has been rethought and optimised to minimise their ecological footprint. Every material has been carefully chosen, with preference given to those produced in France or Europe. The interiors of the chalets tell a story of exceptional craftsmanship and second-hand art, a tribute to the authenticity of those who work with their hands.
